Kit topics include Body Science, Sound and Music, Rocks and Minerals, Optics, Magnets and much, much more!

How does my child receive a kit?

It's easy! Students check out science kits along with their classmates at designated times throughout the year. The kits are delivered to your child's classroom and are returned to the Science Kit room approximately 10 days later!
